For apart from those who know the value, but carelessly neglected the course of giving pure and thorough education to their children, or those chiefs who do not know that their weapons must nolens volens be converted into education al implements: there are those, who when a secondary school in the shape of our Alma Mater "Deo et Patria" was far away from the vicinity of Qyo Province who got clever and willing-tolearn children and whom they desired to send out for better secondary education, but had "no money" to doso, consequently with the exception of those trained freely by the missions, we have few children, of the soil among us to-day who got their trainings at the Grammar School Lagos, in those hard days of trying methods.

It was most pleasing to learn recently of Master Sake Agbaje's success and the "send off " dinner given by his father Mr. S. Agbay, to mark the occasion of his departure to England, where he intended to study medicines—we heartily congratulate our popular townsman Agbaje (Senior) for this. May "Allah-U-banditi mg" bring his son back in peace.

In doing real justice, it is necessary that the Revd. A. B. Akinylee M.A. L. Th., Principal, Grammar School Ibadan under whom Saka received his early-secondary School training ahould be equally congratulated.

But why were no students sent to England before Saka from Ioadan?

The answer is common and simple:—
